- 1- Data sheets and technical details of the proposed solution.
- 2- Brand, Model, and origin of the provided equipment.
- 3- The delivery period & implementation time must be mentioned. Urgent installation will be required as dictated on IOM plan.
- 4- The implementation & equipment costs must be provided in the breakdown list. Lump sum cost is NOT acceptable & will render the proposal to be discarded.
- 5- Responsibility matrix for both IOM & contractor.
- 6- Warranty for the provided equipment and work.
- 7- Any other considerations required to facilitate the implementation.

Standards for Structured Network Cabling

IOM Libya

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Introduction

IOM Libya mission operates various programmes within the region. Its programmes are enabled by ICT services such as internet, email, systems and information management applications all hosted or provisioned through its physical server room infrastructure.

Computer network physical cabling constitutes the foundation used to connect IOM Libya users to the various ICT services.

It is vital to maintain structured IT cabling to ensure a stable and reliable access to ICT services in support of the mission's operational requirements.

The purpose of this document is to provide network cabling standards and guidelines to vendors or third-party entities contracted by IOM for network cabling.

Scope, Constraints and Assumptions

This document outlines standards and general guidelines which must be followed for the new office:

Network cabling work that will be contracted to vendors or third-party entities will be part of a well-scoped project and outlined in a Request for Proposal (RFP) or another form of procurement document.

Note that specification of <u>electrical or power outlets</u> are not included in this document and should be coursed through IOM Libya Procurement Logistics.

Pre-requisites: Site Survey

Contractors who will participate in the bidding process is required to conduct an initial site survey along with an authorized representative from the Information Management and Technology Unit of the International Organization for Migration – Libya to discuss the proposed work and make revisions as required before submitting the final quotation.

Structured Cabling Standards:

The implementation approach of the selected vendor ideally should be aligned with industry standards for network cabling such as ISO/IEC-11801-1: Generic Cabling - General Requirements, ANSI/TIA-942-A Telecommunications Infrastructure Standard for Data Centers, ANSI/TIA-568: Generic Telecommunications Cabling for Customer Premises or ANSI/TIA-569-D Telecommunications Pathways and Spaces.

With reference to the IOM ICT Standard from IN\88, cabling work should be implemented by professional cabling suppliers and <u>certified</u> in accordance with the Telecommunications Industry Association (TIA) or Internationals Organization for Standardization (ISO) standards.





Structured Cabling Guidelines:

The selected vendor or contractor is required to follow these guidelines when working on network cabling in IOM premises.

- 1. An IT focal point will coordinate with the contractor to handover the location and describe the needed work. The IT focal point will provide clarification during the implementation of the work to ensure IOM IT standards and guidelines are met.
- 2. Close coordination with IT focal point must take place to ensure that the planned work will not affect the normal operations of IOM units.
- 3. The contractor must raise any challenges faced during the implementation to the IT focal point to immediately resolve issues and prevent project delays.
- 4. All items quoted and subsequently used in the cabling project must be <u>new</u>. No refurbished or remanufactured item will be accepted (see Item Specifications in the next section).
- 5. Network outlets are to be installed at the predefined locations mapped out on the floor plan as provided by the IT focal point. If the floor plan is not provided, the IT focal point will advise the exact location during the site handover.
- 6. All cabling must be fixed inside adequate trunks. In case gypsum boards are used, cables must be installed inside the boards. Cables then must be routed over the floor ceiling to reach the network distribution cabinet.
- 7. If using PVC trunks, a seamless look should be achieved. The trunks and walls may be painted white if needed to achieve a clean look.
- 8. Number labeling of patch panels and network outlets should use printed-out labels. Do not use permanent markers or indelible inks.
- 9. Patch cords must be properly labeled and color-coded as per below:

a. Uplink points: Yellow (Main Office) Black (MHD)b. IOM Network: Green (Main Office) Black (MHD)

c. Direct Internet: Orange (Main Office)

d. IP Cameras: RED

- 10. Patch cords must be organized with cable organizers.
- 11. Cables should be in an available cable tray, suspended every 4 feet in drop ceilings using J or D style hooks or in an enclosed conduit.
- 12. If a cable tray is not present, provide cable supports at intervals of every 4-6 feet. Cable supports shall be "J" hooks or other supporting devices with a minimum 1-inch cable resting surface.
- 13. Cable support devices shall be independently suspended from or attached to building structure or walls. Cable sag between supports shall not exceed 12 inches. All cables shall be neatly bundled and secured with appropriately rated fasteners or cable ties.





- 14. Cables should not be installed within 4-feet of transformers/motors, when running parallel of power conduits or fluorescent light fixtures maintain a 1 foot separation.
- 15. Network cables must not be installed on the same trunks with the power cables.
- 16. Cabling and all associated equipment must be CAT6 Compliant. The cabling will be required to provide data to network outlets. The contractor will provide parts, materials, installation and testing as outlined.
- 17. The use of RJ-45 Network coupler (back-to-back) is prohibited.
- 18. Whenever required all network cabinets/racks must be cleaned before installation of equipment.
- 19. The contractor must leave the premises clean and neat after each work session.
- 20. The contractor must assume total responsibility for the actions of any/all subcontractors.
- 21. Upon completion of the work, the contractor will hand over the location to the IT focal point to declare and validate the successful implementation of the work as requested. In addition, the contractor must provide testing results of the network outlets through an ISO, TIA credited tools (recommended fluke 8000 or 5000, or any equivalent devices), with documentation of cable runs to meet specifications end-to-end and comply with the warranty conditions mentioned in the proposal for the implemented work.

Item Specifications

The selected vendor is required to use high quality and industry standard cabling components. If unavailable, the vendor may propose similar items of the same specifications and quality and must be approved by the IOM ICT representative.

Purchase Order for Provision of Services

Acceptance of Purchase Order

- Acceptance of this Purchase Order (PO) by the Service Provider shall effect a contract between IOM and the Service Provider (jointly, the "Parties"). The Service Provider's acknowledgement of the PO, provision of any Services under the PO, or acceptance of any Service Fee shall constitute acceptance of the PO. The rights and obligations of the Parties shall be governed solely by the PO which shall include the Standard Terms and Conditions and any Annexes (collectively, the 1.1
- 1.2
- 1.3 No additional or inconsistent provisions proposed by the Service Provider shall bind IOM unless agreed to in writing by a duly authorized IOM official.
- In the event of a conflict between the terms of any Annex to the PO and the Standard Terms and Conditions, the Standard Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
- 1.5 The PO Number must appear on all invoices and correspondence.

2. 2.1 Services Supplied

- The Service Provider agrees to provide the Services as described in the PO in accordance with the Standard Terms and Conditions and any Annexes.
- 2.2 The Service Provider shall commence the provision of Services and fully and satisfactorily complete them by the date indicated and the specifications provided in the PO and any Annexes.

3. The Service Fee

 - The Service Fee specified in this Agreement shall constitute the sole remuneration in connection with this Agreement. The Service Provider shall not accept for its own benefit any trade commission, discount or similar payment in connection with activities pursuant to this Agreement or the discharge of its obligations thereunder. The Service Provider shall ensure that any subcontractors, as well as the personnel and agents of either of them, similarly, shall not receive any such additional remuneration.

- Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in relation to this Agreement, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be settled amicably by negotiation 12.1
- 12.2 In the event that the dispute, controversy or claim has not been resolved by negotiation within 3 (three) months of receipt of the notice from one party of the existence of
- such dispute, controversy or claim, either Party may request that the dispute, controversy or claim is resolved by conciliation by one conciliator in accordance with the UNCITRAL Conciliation Rules of 1980. Article 16 of the UNCITRAL Conciliation Rules does not apply.

 In the event that such conciliation is unsuccessful, either Party may submit the dispute, controversy or claim to arbitration no later than 3 (three) months following the date of termination of conciliation proceedings as per Article 15 of the UNCITRAL Conciliation Rules. 16. Waiver

Failure by either Party to insist in any one or more instances on a strict performance of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver or relinquishment of the right to enforce the provisions of this Agreement in future instances, but this right shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

Termination

- IOM may at any time suspend or terminate this Agreement, in whole or in part, with immediate effect, by providing written notice to the Service Provider, in any case where the mandate of IOM applicable to the performance of the Agreement or the funding of IOM applicable to the Agreement is reduced or terminated. In addition, IOM may suspend or terminate the Agreement upon thirty (30) days' written notice without having to provide any justification.

- No amendment to this Agreement shall be valid or enforceable against IOM unless it is in writing and signed by a duly authorized official of IOM. 20.2
