Annex 1: Terms of Reference

Foreign language training

20 August – 20 September 2023

1. Context

IOM works in close partnership with Libyan authorities to enhance their capacity to respond to the challenges related to migration management. IOM takes up the role of promoting the orderly and humane management of migration, promoting international cooperation on migration issues, supporting relevant actors to govern migration flows and effectively maximize their positive impacts while minimizing the potential costs on migrants and society, as well as providing humanitarian assistance to migrants in need.

Training is a core element of IOM's capacity development initiatives, aiming at providing support, at the request of and in agreement with the national authorities concerned, to enhance states' ability to manage migration holistically, while respecting migrants' fundamental rights. IOM is supporting the Libyan government through enhancing the capacities of-officials-working-in migration management.

Language can be an obstacle for Libyan personnel carrying out search and rescue operations in coordination with other national authorities. In order to conduct safe and effective search and rescue operations at sea, and address the specific needs of migrants, IOM has identified a training program to bridge the communication gap between Libyan officers, national authorities and migrants.

The training program aims to ensure that the specific needs of migrants are considered, and their fundamental rights protected.

Against this background IOM proposes to hold a 25-day Italian language course for officials conducting search and rescue operations at sea.

2. Objectives of the training

The training aims to enhance the ability of Libyan officials to communicate with rescued migrants and other national authorities, through an Italian language course.

3. Specific objective

Participants will learn common Italian terms and expressions, as well as the specific terminology needed to communicate effectively during search and rescue operations. This will be particularly useful in contacting other authorities to support migrants in distress.

4. Methodology

The program is aimed to train 20 officers for a duration of 75 hours for a period of five (5) weeks.

This training will be comprise of interactive conversation sessions and practical exercises moderated by instructors from a local language institution.







A pre/post-training evaluation will be conducted to assess the improvement of participants' knowledge, the quality of delivery, the overall organization and logistics of the training.

5. Targeted participants:

The targeted participants will be as follows:
