1. Context

The Vessel Identification System (VTS) is instrumental in supporting Search and Rescue (SAR) operations at sea, significantly enhancing their efficiency and effectiveness. By furnishing prompt identification / tracking of seacrafts and dependable communication, the VTS serves as a vital tool in maritime safety.

Through the installation of VTS system (Radar and AIS), IOM Libya seeks to enhance the Benghazi Ports Authority's capacity for coordinating Search and Rescue operations at sea. This initiative aims to improve maritime safety standards by ensuring prompt and seamless communication with ships in distress, aligning with international regulations and protocols set forth by the IMO.
